Subjects include:

Aluminum Cans taken to the Fire Station at 36185 Detroit Road help the ACBC (Aluminum Cans for Burned Children) program.

Plastic Beverage Bottles (#1 PET beverage bottles) taken to the Dream Machine at the Center Ridge Marathon Service Station (32700 Center Ridge Road, North Ridgeville) help Veterans with Disabilities (EBV).

Used Motor Oil and Tires: Make arrangements to dispose of old motor oil and tires at the Avon Walmart, 35901 Chester Road, by calling their Tire & Lube Department at 440-937-4750. There is a 5 gallon daily limit for oil and a small fee for tires.

Yard Waste Removal: Information includes dates, types of containers to be used, what is considered "yard waste" and details of other locations able to dispose of yard waste.

Appliances: For old refrigerators, freezers or air conditioners that are still working but running inefficiently enough to consider replacing contact First Energy at 877-545-4112.

Shredding of Sensitive Documents:

- For **Avon residents** only, Details for 2014 will be in the Press and notices posted on the City's web site at www.cityofavon.com.
- For **Lorain County residents** only, Dates for 2014 to be announced. This will take place at the Lorain County Solid Waste District Collection Center (540 Abbe Road, Elyria). ID is required for proof of residency. Limit is 5 boxes or 5 blue grocery bags per vehicle. Boxes must be taken home. Do not exit your vehicle.

Hangers Kohl's only: Hangers that came with purchases at Kohl's may be returned for recycling.

This is a drive-through service. Simply drive into the open bay door. There will be attendants on hand to remove the materials from your vehicle

Corrosives

- acids
- caustics
- rechargeable batteries
- button batteries
- hydraulic brake fluid
- automotive (wet cell) batteries

Toxics

- household bleach
- antifreeze
- herbicides, pesticides
- mercury & mercury devices
- roofing tar
- concrete sealers
- fire extinguishers

Flammables

- latex-based paints/stains/sealers
- oil-based paints/stains/sealers
- aerosol cans
- turpentine, paint thinner
- adhesives
- solvents
- oven cleaners
- lighter fluid
- butane lighter fluid
- oil filters
- propane tanks (up to 33 lbs. only)
- oxygen & MAPP gas cylinders

Reactives

- fertilizers
- pool chlorine
- oxidizers

Scrap Tires

- 10 tire limit (no larger than 20" diameter rims)
- tires may be on or off rims
- all bicycle & motorcycle tires

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE continued

Fluorescent Lamps & Ballast

- straight fluorescent tubes, all lengths (including Green Tipped tubes)
- all U-shaped, circular and odd shaped fluorescent lamps
- compact fluorescent lamps (CFL)
- neon lights and signs (tubing only)
- high intensity discharge (HID) bulbs, HPS, MH, & MV
- ballasts & transformers from all fluorescent light fixtures

E-Scrap (computers, TVs, other electronics)

- personal computers (CPU)
- video monitors (CRT)
- flat-screen monitors
- mice, keyboards, joysticks
- printers, plotters, scanners
- hard drives, tape drives
- computer speakers
- diskette drives, CD drives
- data terminals, modems
- servers, network hardware
- UPS systems
- cables, circuit boards
- software, tapes, diskettes, CDs
- desktop office equipment (calculators, typewriters, fax machines, etc.)
- household televisions (up to 27" only, NO large console TVs)
- home audio equipment
- microwave ovens
- smoke detectors
- reference manuals, books
- all refillable printer cartridges
- all cell phones (preferably with their batteries, chargers & other accessories)

Materials NOT acceptable

- ammunition, explosives, road flares
- biomedical/infectious waste
- NO APPLIANCES OF ANY TYPE, except microwaves
- used motor oil or transmission fluid
- curbside recyclable materials as listed
- radioactive materials, EXCEPT smoke detectors
- non-fluorescent lamps (household bulbs, spotlights, headlights, etc.)
- televisions with a width greater than 27"
- console televisions
- non-rechargeable batteries (e.g. AAA through D and 9V for remotes, flashlights, etc.)
